All Coaches coaching Novice, Atom, Pee wee, Bantam, Midget community sport streams as determined by the Branch Coaches must complete On-line / In-Class portions within two years of being trained in order to maintain status					
Certification Maintenance					
Certification maintenance is not required at Coach 2 however, coaches can still receive points at this level if they choose to take professional development
