ROCKLAND, ON – Hockey Eastern Ontario is proud to be the host Branch for the 2018 Central Region Midget AAA Championship which is part of the Road to the TELUS Cup. This season, AAA teams from Victoria to St. John's will face off for the right to be called national champions; the LHMAAAQ champions advance directly to the TELUS Cup as Quebec representatives, while the other four regional spots will be filled by the champions of Pacific, West, Central and Atlantic Championship. These championships are a showcase event for players 15 to 17 years of age.

The Central Region Midget AAA Championship is a weeklong event that will showcase the top Midget teams from two of the three Ontario branches of Hockey Canada. A total of six teams compete at this event which include the championship teams from the OHF comprised of representatives from the Alliance, GTHL, OMHA, and NOHA. HEO will boast a host team and a representative team which are to be announced the third week of March.

The 1st puck drops on April 2nd, 2018 at 12pm with Opening Ceremonies scheduled for 6pm. This family friendly tournament will include a 19 game schedule which will conclude with the Gold Medal game and closing ceremonies on April 8th at the CIHA arena in Rockland.

"It is a pleasure to have the Central Region Midget AAA Championship return to Hockey Eastern Ontario (HEO)" said HEO President and Midget AAA Championship Steering Committee Chair Barbara Levere. "We are looking forward to having the teams arrive from across Ontario and hope that this event is a memorable experience for all participants as well as patrons".
